Materials for each Terrarium*:

- 16 g 15° Japanese seed beads (A)
- 8 g 11° Japanese seed beads (B)
- 30 g Japanese Tila beads
- (80) 3x6mm DropDuo beads
- Fireline thread, 6 lb test

Components to fill your Terrarium:

- Geode Terrarium: crystals and seed beads in six color sets.
- Succulent Terrarium: leaf beads and seed beads in eight color sets.
- Flower Terrarium: petal beads and seed beads in six color sets.

Materials for the Geode Crystals:

- 28 g 15° Japanese seed beads (C)
- 2 g 15° Japanese seed beads (D) (in each of six colors to match the crystals)
- 2 g 15° Japanese seed beads (E) (in each of six colors)
- 1 g 15° Japanese seed beads (F) (in each of six colors)
- 10 g 11° Japanese seed beads (G)
- 10 g 11° Japanese seed beads (H)
- (8) 6mm flat back crystals (in each of six colors)
- (6) 8mm lotus round crystals (in each of six colors)
- (4) 10mm lotus round crystals (in each of six colors)
- (2) 14mm lotus round crystals (in each of six colors)

The Geode Terrarium contains four types of bezeled crystals: etched lotus crystals in 14mm, 10mm, and 8mm, as well as 6mm flat back crystals.



Materials for the

Succulents:

- 12 g 15° Japanese seed beads (C)
- 2-3 g 15° Japanese seed beads
 (D) (in each of eight colors to match the leaves)
- 0.5 g 11° Japanese seed beads
 (E) (in each of eight colors)
- 2-3 g 8° Japanese seed beads
 (F) (in each of eight colors)
- 1-3 g of the following beads* (in each of eight colors):
 - Rizo beads
 - Gekko beads
 - Dragon Scale beads
 - DropDuo beads
 - Pip beads
- 1-3 g of the following beads* (in each of four of the above eight colors):
 - 2.8mm Miyuki drop beads
 - 3.4mm Miyuki drop beads
 - 3x5.5mm Miyuki long drop beads
 - 4x7mm Miyuki long magatama beads
- Fireline thread, 6 lb test

*Not all color sets need to have each bead. See below.



- One **small** and one **large Rounded** succulents, stitched with DropDuos, Rizos, and Pip beads, as well as 15° and 8° Japanese seed beads.
- One **small** and one **large Pointed** succulents, stitched with Gekko and Dragon Scale beads, as well as 15°, 11°, and 8° Japanese seed beads.
- One stitched with 3.4mm drop and long magatama Miyuki beads, as well as 15° and 11° Japanese seed beads.
- One stitched with 2.8mm, 3.4mm and long **drop** Miyuki beads, and 15° Japanese seed beads.

We'll stitch these succulents in sets of eight colors. Some color sets will contain all six types, and some will have fewer types. You'll need to stitch at least 20 large succulents and 70 of some combination of the four smaller succulents.

Materials for the Flowers:

- 20 g 15° Japanese seed beads (C)
- 2-3 g 15° Japanese seed beads (D) (in each of six colors to match the petals)
- 3-4 g 15° Japanese seed beads (E) (in each of six colors)
- 3 g 15° Japanese seed beads (F)
- 2 g 11° Japanese seed beads (G)
- 1-4 g of the following beads (in each of six colors*):
 - 3.4mm Miyuki drop beads or 4x6mm Czech drop beads
 - Dragon Scale beads
 - O beads
 - 6mm lentil beads
- 1-3 g of the following beads (in each of two of the above six colors*):
 - 2.8mm Miyuki drop beads
 - 6mm lentil beads
- Fireline thread, 6 lb test
- *Not all color sets need to have each bead. See below.



- Three **basic flowers** stitched with either Miyuki drop (2.8 or 3.4mm), Dragon Scale, or 4x6mm Czech drop beads, as well as 15° Japanese seed beads.
- One stitched with Czech lentil beads and 15° and 11° Japanese seed beads.
- One stitched with **O beads** and 15° and 11° Japanese seed beads.

We'll stitch these flowers in sets of six colors. Some color sets will have all three types, while some will have fewer types. You'll need to stitch some combination of at least 120 flowers.
